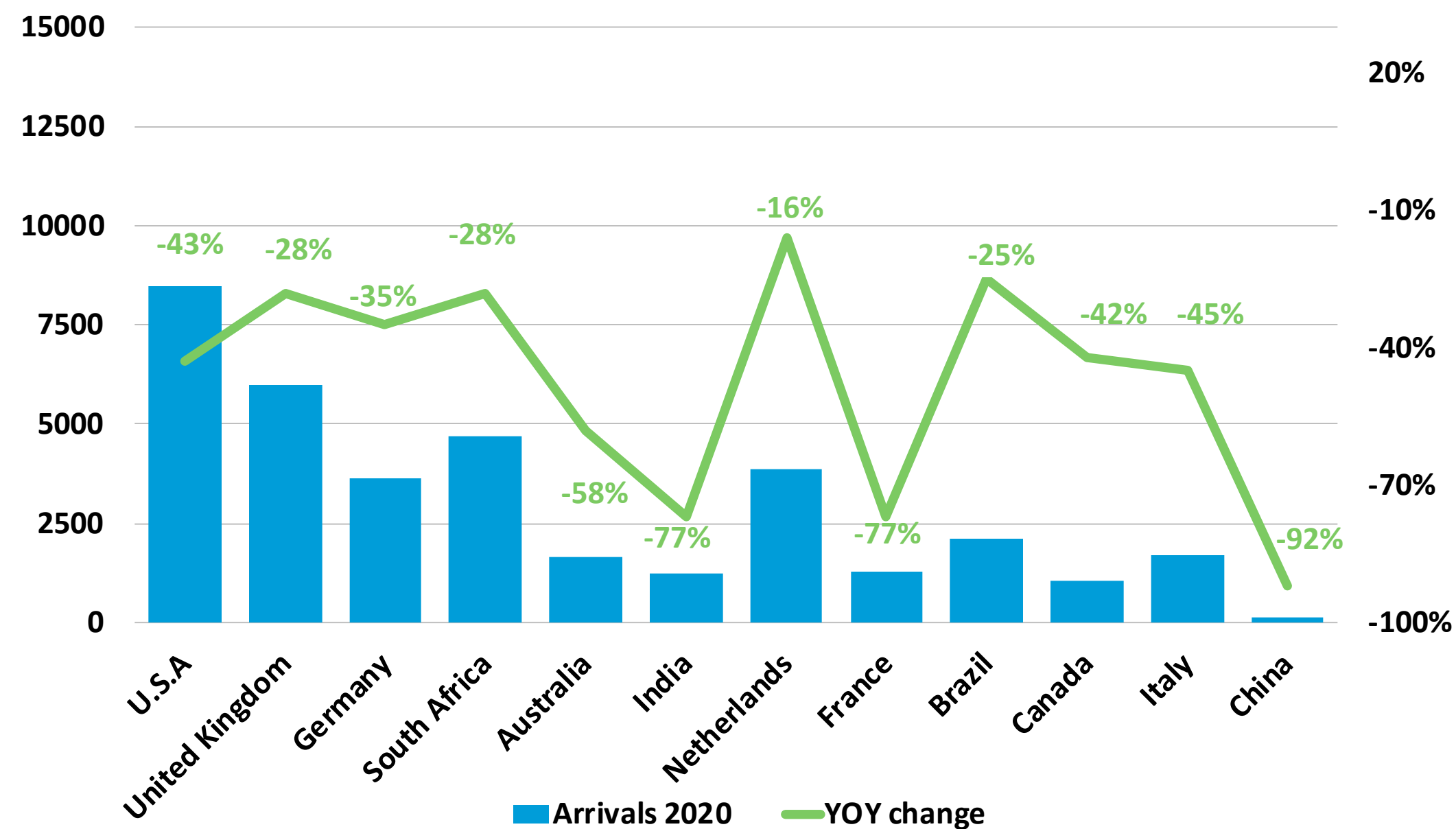

Lockdown 27 March – 16 April: Banned non-essential domestic and international travel

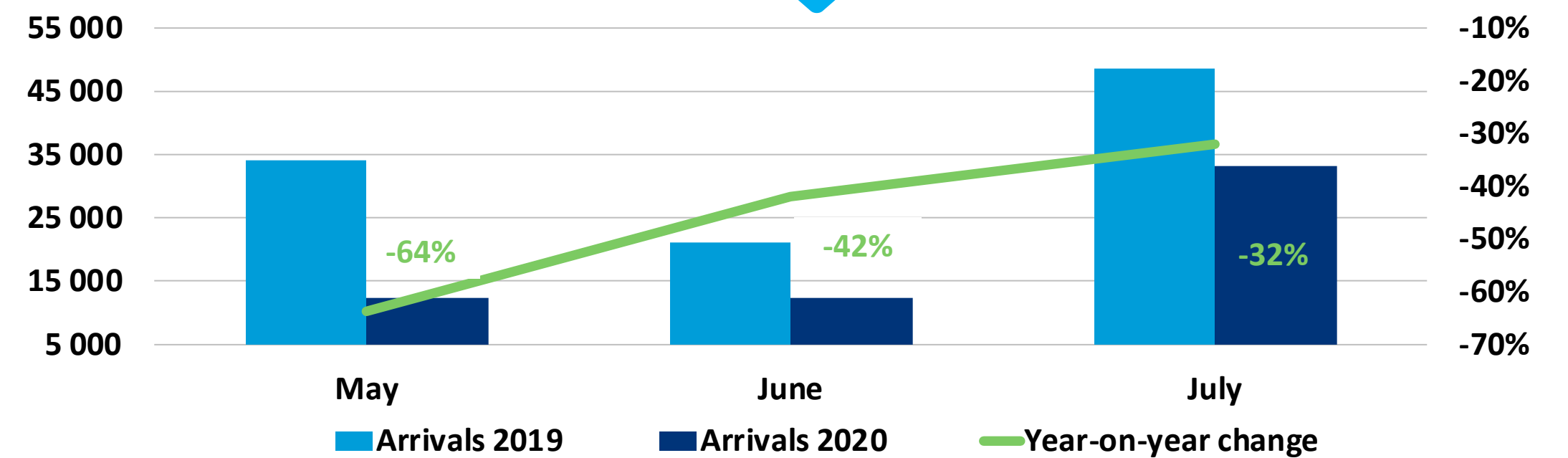
% FORECAST CHANGE FOR TOP 10 INTERNATIONAL SOURCE MARKETS + SOUTH AFRICA AND CHINA
